

WHAT IS THE INTENTION OF CAREERS AT WADEBRIDGE SCHOOL

Young people who are **fully informed** and possess the **skills** to give themselves a chance to achieve their **potential**!!

Types of Qualification on Offer at Wadebridge

GCSE: General Certificate of Education.

- Graded 1 to 9, with 9 being the top grade.
- 100% written examination, apart from in practical subjects, like Art and Drama, where there is an element of
 controlled assessment (tasks completed under the supervision of the teacher).
- Exams take place at the end of the course (no modules).
- No exam tiers e.g. Higher/Foundation, except in Maths, Science and Modern Foreign Languages.

Vocational qualifications and technical awards.

- alternative national qualification to GCSEs.
- Equivalent in standard to one GCSE.
- Graded from Level 1 pass to Level 2 Distinction *
- Offer a more applied, skills-based learning route, with a greater emphasis on assessment through controlled assessment (up to 70%), although there will still be some external assessments, for example online tests.
- Offered by established accreditation boards, such as BTEC, OCR, AQA and NCFE.

Very important to remember

Option forms show preferences and can not be guaranteed

However:

In 2024 NO students had to take a subject that was not on their form at all (some had to take their reserve)

In any case where a reserve subject was required contact would be made with home.

All courses are confirmed in writing after the options forms have been processed



Reasons we can't guarantee preferences

- To run a subject it needs to have enough students
- Some subjects have large numbers of students and are available on every block so every student can have a place in these
- Some subjects have smaller numbers and we can only offer one class in one block
- If 2 subjects are chosen which only have one class in the same block they could clash – a preference would then be sought



Can Options be changed?

Deadline for changes to Option subjects is October half term of Year 9

We have to be strict about this deadline to be fair to all students and staff

We take great care to make student choices work within the timetable therefore it is very important that you find out as much as possible and take time making choices


